LIST OF SCHOOL REQUIREMENTS FOR 2023.

1. NURSERY SCHOOL

- Indoor playing materials like Puzzles, reading games, Mathematics games, Playing toys, Blocks(woody), Reading books and bible story books.

- Outside Playing materials like Swings, Circus, Swimming Ponds, Gig saws

2. PRIMARY SCHOOL.

- Academic. Photocopier and office laptop.

- Co-curricular. Netball(bibs, skirts and net balls), Football (bibs, Jazzes, Foot balls, Football shoes and stockings), Music (Rattles, skirts)

- Casual wear T-shirts blue color.

3. SECONDARY SCHOOL.

- Skilling department (Electric Oven and Mixing bawls for bakery classes, Rechargeable Speakers and Microphones for Music Classes, Tailoring materials like Cloths, threads for tailoring classes)

- Sports. Football (balls, training corns, bibs, shoes, stockings, match day Jazzes), Netball (Balls, bibs and match day kits.), Valley Ball (balls and Nets)

- Casual wear (red for S1-S4 and gray for S5-S6)

- Sanitary towels for girls.

We will be using the money raised from the LDST fund raising day and other donations (local churches etc) to purchase some of these requirements.

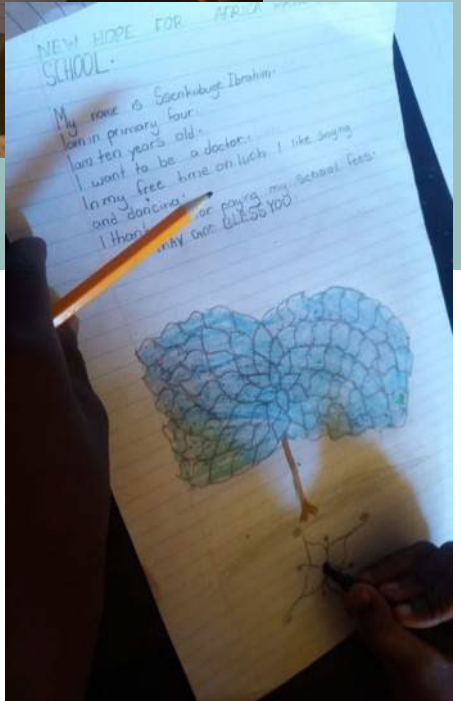
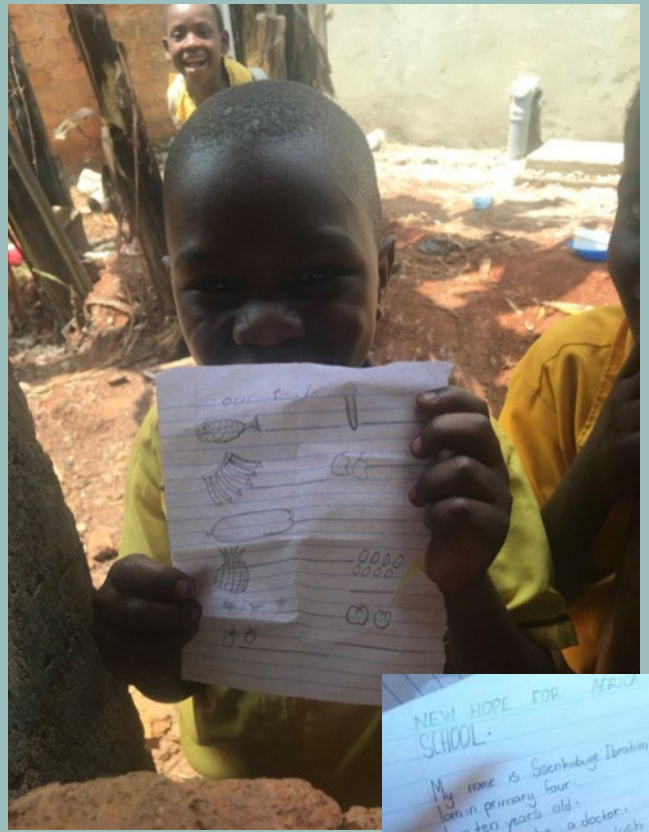
We are also taking over reading books that are from schemes that we no longer use.

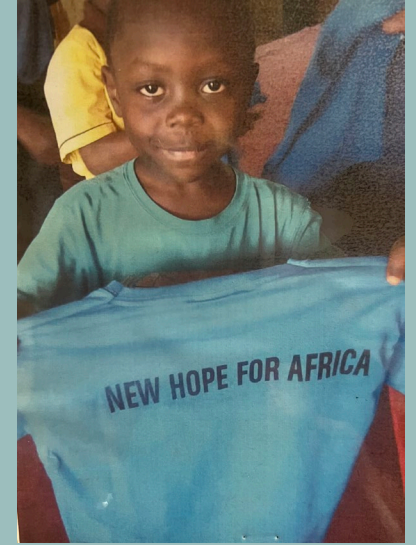

Youngsters step up to help school in Uganda by donating old shoes

PUPILS at St Andrews C of E primary school in Maghull have been stepping up their fundraising efforts to help a school in Uganda.

Teaching assistant Maxene Kidman visits the New Hope School in Uganda every year to carry out the school sponsorship programme and to take donations from fundraising events.

One team member this year was an ex-pupil at St Andrews.

In previous years, St Andrews children have carried out fund raising for blue and red t-shirts which is part of the school uniform at New Hope.

This year, Paula Dwan, deputy head of St Andrews, came up with an idea that the children could go to school in casual footwear and bring old school shoes, which could be taken over to New Hope School. A total of 122 pairs of shoes were col-

lected.

Maxene said: "Thank you to the support and kindness of the parents and children at St Andrews. The shoes taken over were humbly received and the children and staff at New Hope were forever grateful."

"We also bought mosquito nets, mattresses, school uniform, school desks along with many other items with donation money received. South Sefton football team kindly donated a football strip as well."

New Hope for Africa (UK) is a non-profit making charity which aims to transform the lives of disadvantaged children and young people in Uganda.

The charity's aim is to provide a safe and caring environment where the youngsters will be nurtured, educated, and helped to achieve their potential in life and so equipped to build a better future for themselves.

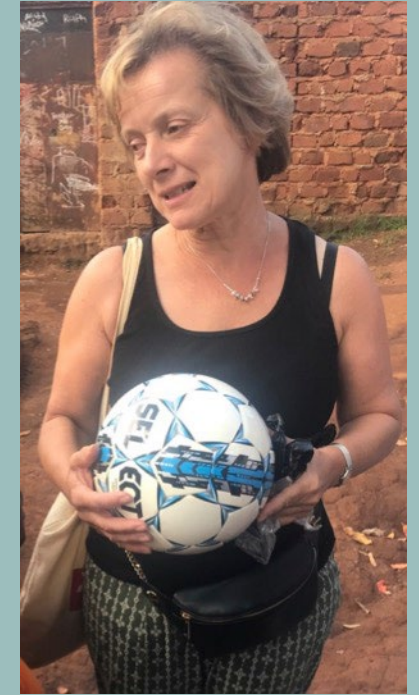
Shoe donations from St Andrew's C of E Maghull which were sent over during the last visit to New Hope



Some of the children need new mattresses



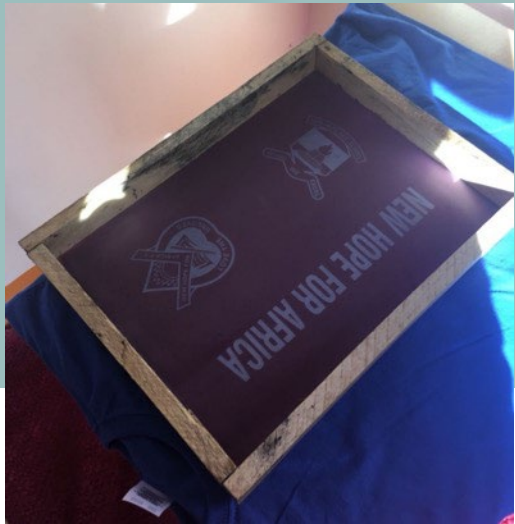
In previous years, we have helped to purchase firewood, and paint for medical centre
